 - The other 5 works can be any medium (ceramics, painting, photography, sculpture, design, etc.) that the student feels best represents their current skill set.
 - Work should be submitted as a PowerPoint* Slide Show (saved as .pps)
 - Slide background color should be black, do not use any special effects, text color should be white.
 - The following text should be typed under each piece of artwork:
 - Title

- Date created
- Size
- Medium
- Indicate if work was created in or out of class

- All artwork must be original and copies of previously published work including magazines, cd covers, comic books, etc. will not be accepted or considered.

- ___ File should be saved as lastname_firstname_middle initial.pps (i.e.: mcfalls_elizabeth_r.pps)
- ___ CD should be clearly labeled with student's full legal name, mailing address, phone number & email address
- ___ Letter of recommendation from an art teacher
- ___ Copy of high school transcript for Incoming Freshmen / College transcript for Transfer Students
